As you know we are only getting pothole repair, not resurfacing, but a filled pothole is better than the alternative.</p>

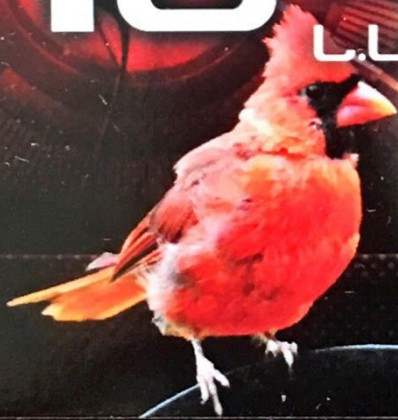
