## **PACC annual report: shelter outpaces national trends in positive outcomes**

The Pima Animal Care Center (PACC) took in 17,081 pets and achieved a live release rate of 90.68 percent, according to the Center's 2023 Annual Report. Among the report's highlights was a 42 percent increase in the reporting of lost and found pets due to PACC's implementation of PetcoLove Lost, a no-cost national platform that uses pet facial recognition to help identify lost pets. PACC continues to outpace the national trend in most areas, according to Shelters Animal Count, a nonprofit foundation that maintains animal sheltering statistics nationwide.
