Pima County, Ariz. (Mar 28) – On Monday, March 31, through Tuesday, April 8, 2025, from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., Pima County Department of Transportation and its contractor, Sunland Asphalt, will be performing fog seal treatments at the following locations:

- Snyder Road from Valle to Hidden Valley Road
- Snyder Road from Palisade Drive to Soldier Trail
- Ina Road from La Cholla Boulevard to west of Camino de la Tierra
- Rudasill Road from Oracle Road to 1st Avenue
- Fort Lowell Road from Houghton Road to Soldier Trail
- Houghton Road from Fort Lowell Road to Flintlock Trail
- Oracle Jaynes Station Road from Mona Lisa Road to San Joaquin Avenue

The work will consist of setting traffic control and fog sealing

Due to the project area limitations, turn movements within the work zones may be restricted. Minor delays and lane closures may also occur. Please approach the areas with caution, obey all traffic control devices and allow for extra travel time.

In the event of mechanical failure or inclement weather, the construction schedule is subject to change.

In Fiscal Year 2024/2025, the Pima County Board of Supervisors and Transportation Department allocated \$24 million in road repair and preservation funding for the Road
