## Pima County seeks public input on Community Wildfire Protection Plan

PIMA COUNTY, Feb. 19, 2026 -- Pima County is inviting the public to review and comment on the update to the [Community Wildfire Protection Plan \(CWPP\)](#). The plan is a collaborative effort to reduce wildfire risk and help communities better prepare for and recover from wildfires.

The CWPP identifies wildfire hazards, prioritizes at-risk communities, and outlines strategies to protect lives, property, infrastructure, and natural resources.

Pima County faces many wildfire risks due to its mix of desert, grassland, and forested landscapes. Other challenges include invasive fire-prone species such as buffelgrass, communities with limited evacuation routes, and continued growth where development meets wildland. Reducing these risks requires coordinated planning and input from agencies and residents.

To make it easy for the public to take part, Pima County has launched an [online CWPP hub](#). Residents, landowners, and stakeholders can review the draft Community Wildfire Protection Plan and [submit comments](#) to help shape the final version.

**The public review period is open until March 2.**

The update is being developed in coordination with local fire districts, emergency management, land management agencies, utilities, tribal partners, and other stakeholders. It also uses the most current data on wildfire risk, fuels, and community vulnerabilities.
